19 and 21 of May 2021

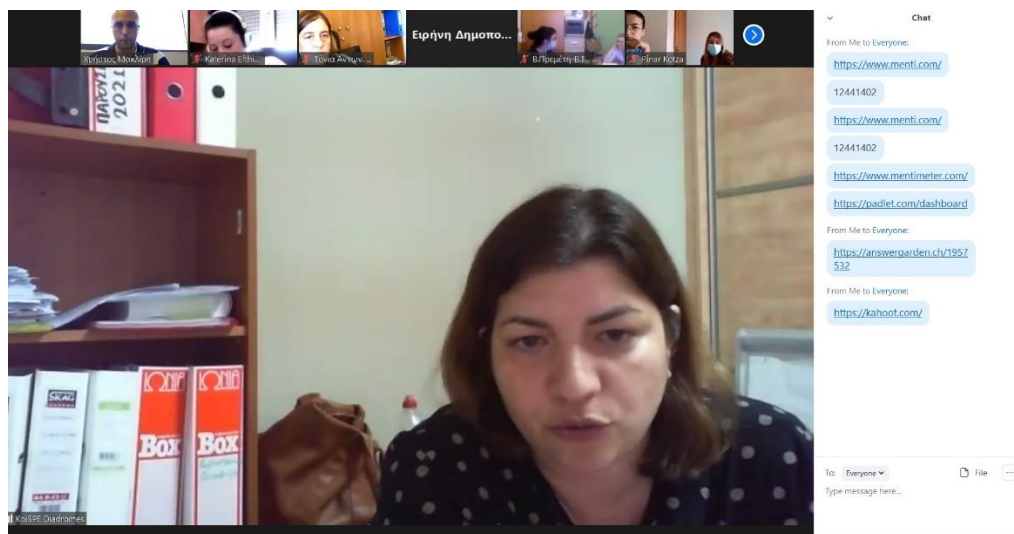

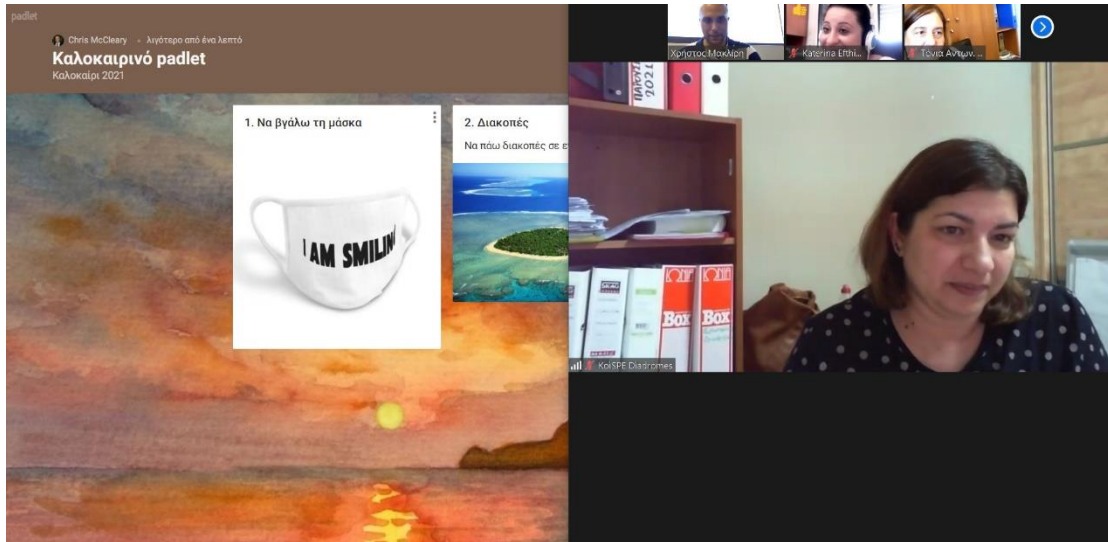

Webinar on the 19th of May: Presentation of online digital tools.

On the 19th of May, the project coordinator of KOISPE Diadromes mr Chris Makliri with the support of the administrative responsible ms Nafsika Papadimitratou, presented the online tools Padlet, Mentimeter, Answergarden and Kahoot.



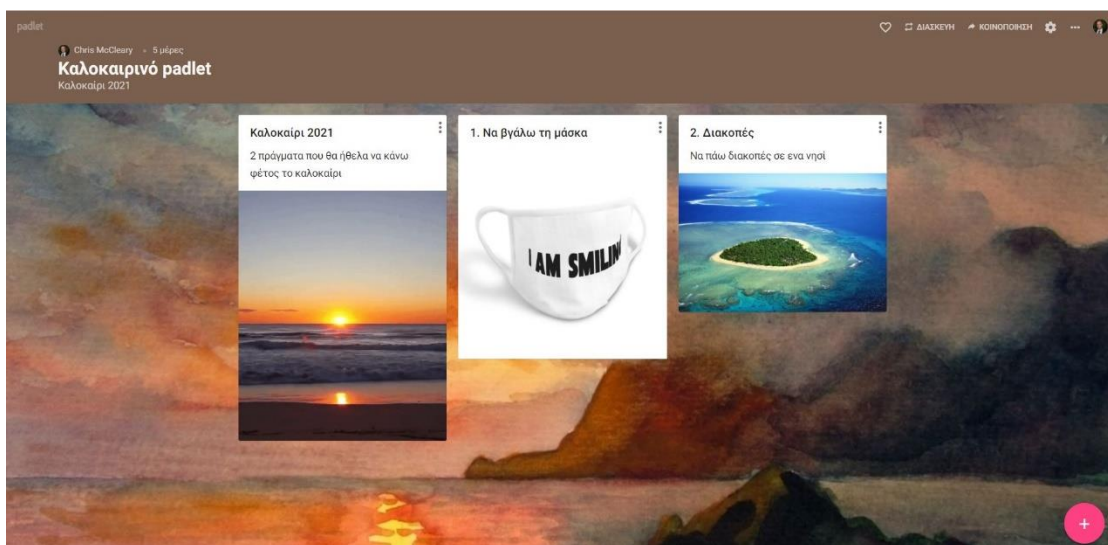
Employees of KOISPE Diadromes and representatives of other Social Cooperatives and NGOs attended the meeting. During the 1,5-hour webinar, the participants answered questions via Mentimeter and Answerganden, learned about how to use Padlet and its functions and proposed to download and use Kahoot. The language we used was Greek and the number of the participants was 16.

Webinar on the 21st of May: Presentation of basic online applications.

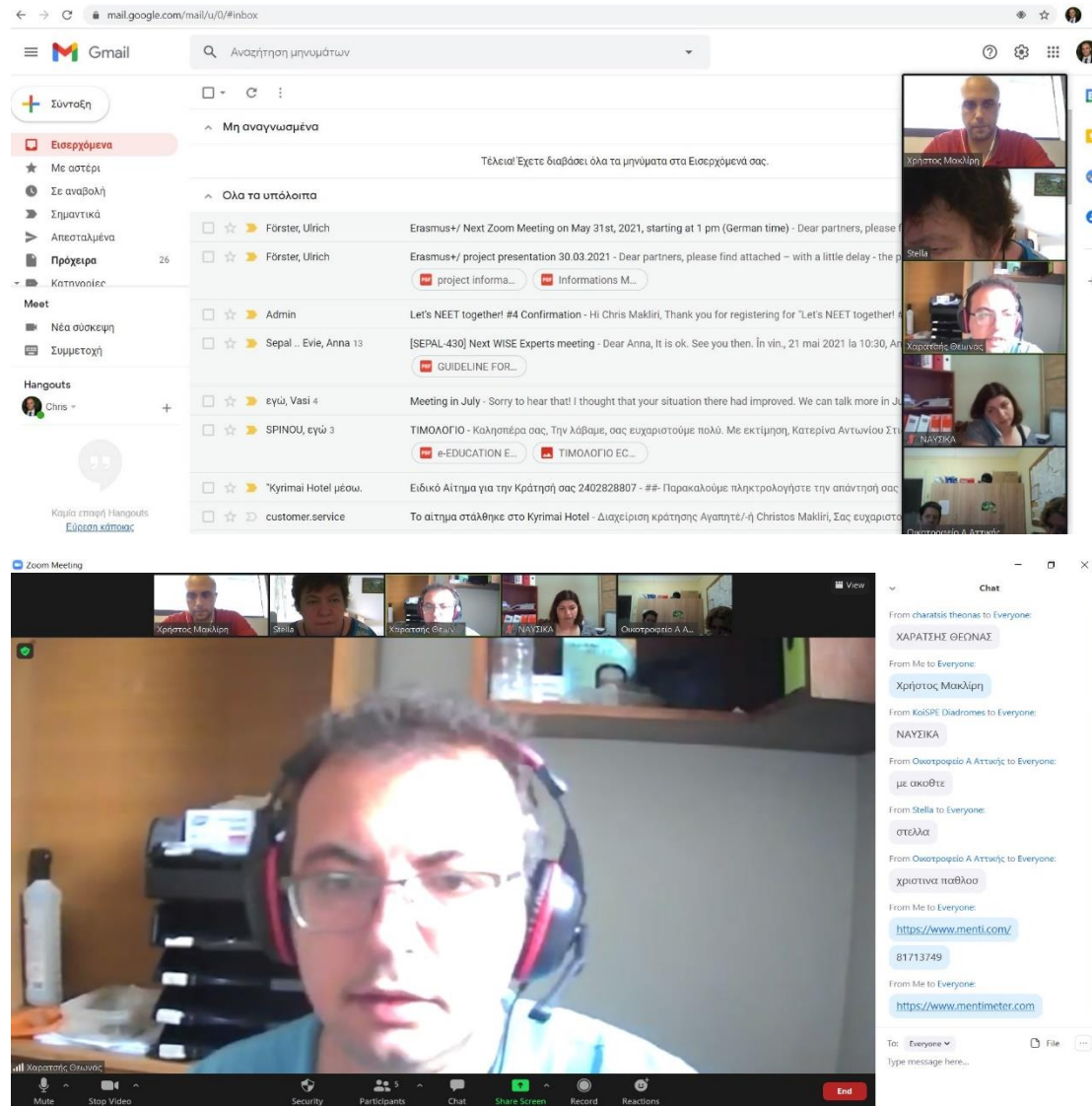
On the 21st of May, KOISPE Diadromes organized the second webinar which was addressed to individuals with limited digital competencies. Participants were some of our beneficiaries, people with diagnosed mental health disabilities.

The meeting took place for 1,5 hour and the mood was very positive. Mr Chris Makliri firstly presented the basic functions of ZOOM and asked from the participants to use the chat, the reactions and other possibilities of the ZOOM platform.



An interest part was when we presented some Google applications to the participants.

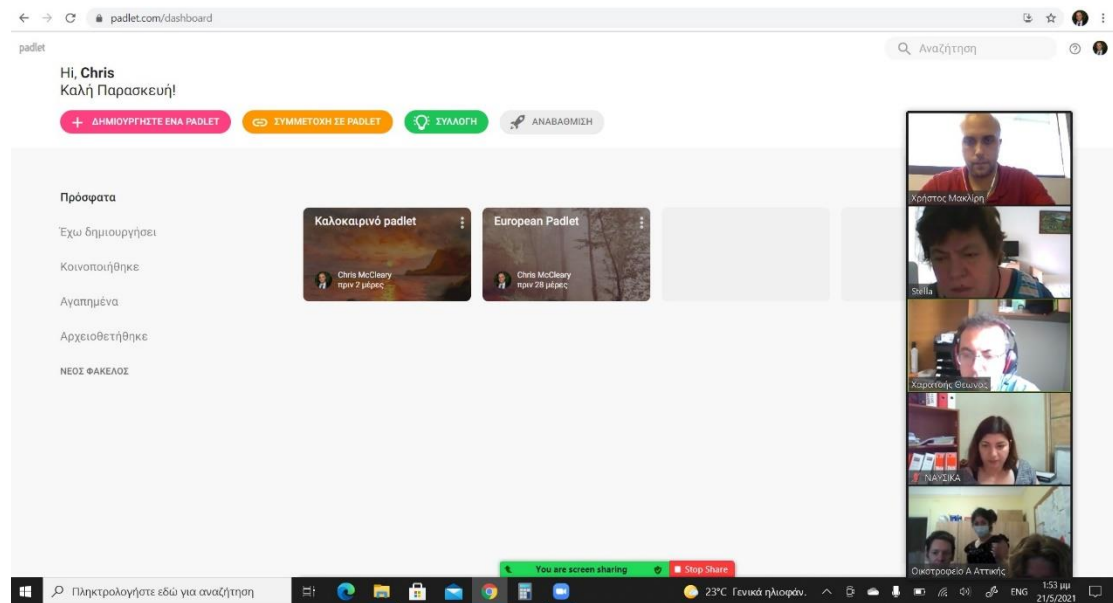
We explained the usefulness of Gmail and how to create and use it in formal and non-formal way, and we presented Google Maps as an important tool for moving around the city and not only.



An interest tasks was when we asked the participants to answer a question via Mentimeter, about their summer expectations. Most of the answers were about vacation and meeting their relatives.



We also presented a small description with the basic functions of Padlet.



We closed the webinar explaining to our beneficiaries, why it is so important to improve digital skills and learn as many online applications as possible. The participants enjoyed a lot the webinar and ensured us that we will be in contact in order to provide them guidance for the improvement of their digital competencies.
